Work with a partner or with a group to find these artifacts! Find the **artifact** and **answer the questions** about the artifact. Start in building #1, and go up the stairs to the mezzanine, then through the back door to building #2. After you have located all the answers, come to the office to enter your name to win a prize. **Hint!** The signs by these items have the answers.

1. Find the airplane on the ceiling. What was it used for?
2. Locate the model steam engine. How long did it take to make?
3. Find the sign with Mr. J. Shortreed's name on it. How much money did Mr. Shortreed want for this 40
acres of land?
4. Find the washboards. How many are there?
5. Can you find the two-headed calf? How long did it live?
6. Locate the rope-making exhibit. Can you name 3 different types of twine that were used to make ropes?
7. Locate the horseshoe display case. What animal is the smallest horseshoe used on?
8. Find the hen in the display case and fill in the blanks: This hen laid eggs in days and went to the world fair in!
9. Find the year of the oldest license plate in the license plate collection.
10. Where was the historic Moir Blacksmith shop originally located?
11. Locate the Ford Model T truck. Write something interesting you notice about the truck.
12. Can you find the cauldron? What was it used for?
13. Find the Dempster windmill. What fluid did it pump?
14. What kind of tires does the Caterpillar tractor have?
15. What simple machines can you identify in the Red Stone Sawmill? (For example: wheel and axle, incline

plane, lever, pulley, wedge.) Find at least two and state what the items are.
